TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Participation constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Tournament Rules
2. The Pensacola Greyhound Track Poker Room (PGT) will sponsor a \$20k Guarantee No-Limit Texas Hold'em Tournament.
3. There will be three day one events:
 - a. Day 1-A will be held on Thursday, May 25, 2017 at 1pm
 - b. Day 1-B will be held on Friday, May 26, 2017 at 1pm
 - c. Day 1-C will be held on Saturday, May 27, 2017 at 1pm
 - d. Each day one event will play down to 10% of the entries or to the end of level 10, whichever comes first.
4. Day two (Final) will begin at 1:00pm, Sunday, May 28, 2017 at 1pm and resume play where the earliest Day 1 event was completed and continue until the tournament is completed.
5. The buy-in fee for the tournaments will be \$180
 - a. The entry fee for the tournament will be \$120 (100% of the prize money will be returned to the players)
 - b. The Tournament Revenue Fee will be \$30
 - c. \$10 will be withheld for the Jackpot Reserve Fee
 - d. \$20 will be withheld for the Staff Token Pool
6. Blind round 1-4 will run for thirty (30) minutes, levels 5-8 will run for Forty-five (45) min, and blind levels 9 on will run for sixty (60) min. (the tournament blind schedule is available upon request)
7. Participants will receive \$10,000 in tournament chips upon entering the Tournament
8. Late entries, re-entries and alternates will be allowed for the first six rounds (180 minutes) and the first two ten minute breaks
 - a. Players may enter and re-enter on Day 1-A, Day 1-B and Day 1-C
 - b. If a player advances to Day 2 from more than one day one events, they will play the highest chip stack and the other stack will be removed from play.
9. Participants must be 18 years of age or older and provide a valid ID if requested
10. If a player elects not to contribute to the staff token pool then the money will be transferred to the house revenue.
11. The Tournament will be conducted in accordance with the Tournament Directors Association (TDA) Rules
 - a. By participating, entrants agree to abide by the terms of these Tournament Rules and to the decisions of PGT Management and to waive any right to claim ambiguity in the Tournament or these Tournament Rules
 - b. Current TDA rules are available upon request

PAYOUTS

1. At any point during a tournament after the completion of the buy-in period, the remaining players may agree to distribute the prize money differently than the posted payout schedule.
 - a. Any agreement reached must be unanimous and will be indicated by each player pushing a stack of his or her chips forward.
 - b. Poker Room Management will notify the Division any time players choose to distribute the prize money in any way other than as specified in the tournament rules.
 - c. Player of the month points:
 - i. If there is a chop of the prize money, the posted prize money for each position will be used to determine the player of the month points, not the actual cash received from the chop.
 - ii. Each position will be determined by chip count
 - iii. If there is a tie in chip count the players that are tied will split the total points of the tied positions.
2. 100% of the prize money will be returned to the players and will be administered and paid by the Poker Room Management
3. Other prizes including but not limited to trophies or plaques and promotional items may be awarded in addition to the prize money

INDEMNIFICATION AND RELEASE

1. PGT Poker Room reserves the right to refuse entry into the tournament
2. All winners will be required to provide their name, current address and telephone number which will be stored as a record of the prize received
3. Participation in this tournament and/or acceptance of a prize payout constitutes permission for PGT Poker Room to use the participant's names, likenesses and statements for promotional and publicity purposes without additional compensation or limitation unless prohibited by law
4. The PGT Poker Room has attempted to cover every rule, procedure and circumstance that may occur during this tournament. In the event a decision is necessary that is not covered by the above, PGT Poker Room Supervisory Personnel will make that decision
5. The Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering reserves the right to investigate any and all complaints and disputes regarding tournaments, promotions and drawings
6. Management reserves the right to cancel, change and modify tournaments, promotions or drawings with notification to the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering
