TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Participation constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Tournament Rules
2. The Pensacola Greyhound Track Poker Room (PGT) will sponsor a Epilepsy Charity Event on the following dates and times:
 - a. 7:00 PM Friday, Nov. 17, 2017, \$90 Buy-in No Limit Texas Hold'em Tournament
 - b. 1:00 PM Saturday, Nov. 18, 2017, \$90 Buy-in No Limit Texas Hold'em Tournament
3. The buy-in fee for the tournament on Friday, Nov. 17, 2017, will be \$90
 - a. The entry fee for the tournament will be \$55 (100% of the prize money will be returned to the players)
 - b. The Tournament Revenue Fee will be \$10
 - c. \$5 will be withheld for the Jackpot Reserve Fund
 - d. \$10 will be withheld for the Staff Toke Pool
 - e. \$10 will be withheld for the Epilepsy Foundation
 - i. Each blind round will run for fifteen (20) minutes (the tournament blind schedule is available upon request)
 - ii. Participants will receive \$8,000 in tournament chips upon entering a tournament
 - iii. Late entries, re-entries and alternates will be allowed for the first three rounds and the first ten minute break (70 minutes)
4. The buy-in fee for the tournament on Saturday, Nov. 18, 2017, will be \$90
 - a. The entry fee for the tournament will be \$55 (100% of the prize money will be returned to the players)
 - b. The Tournament Revenue Fee will be \$10
 - c. \$5 will be withheld for the Jackpot Reserve Fund
 - d. \$10 will be withheld for the Staff Toke Pool
 - e. \$10 will be withheld for the Epilepsy Foundation
 - i. Each blind round will run for fifteen (20) minutes (the tournament blind schedule is available upon request)
 - ii. Participants will receive \$8,000 in tournament chips upon entering a tournament
 - iii. Late entries, re-entries and alternates will be allowed for the first three rounds and the first ten minute break (70 minutes)
5. Participants must be 18 years of age or older and possess a valid ID
6. Any additional prize payouts will be paid from the Jackpot Reserve Fund
7. If a player elects not to contribute to the staff toke pool then the money will be transferred to the house revenue.
8. The tournaments will be conducted in accordance with the Tournament Directors Association (TDA) Rules
 - a. By participating, entrants agree to abide by the terms of these Tournament Rules and to the decisions of PGT Management and to waive any right to claim ambiguity in the tournament or these Tournament Rules
 - b. Current TDA rules are available upon request

PAYOUTS

1. At any point during a tournament after the completion of the buy-in period, the remaining players may agree to distribute the prize money differently than the posted payout schedule. The tournament payout schedule is available upon request.
 - a. Any agreement reached must be unanimous and will be indicated by each player pushing a stack of his or her chips forward.
 - b. Poker Room Management will notify the Division any time players choose to distribute the prize money in any way other than as specified in the tournament rules.
 - c. Player of the month points:
 - i. If there is a chop of the prize money, the posted prize money for each position will be used to determine the player of the month points, not the actual cash received from the chop.
 - ii. Each position will be determined by chip count
 - iii. If there is a tie in chip count the players that are tied will split the total points of the tied positions.
2. 100% of the prize money will be returned to the players and will be administered and paid by the Poker Room Management
3. Other prizes including but not limited to trophies or plaques and promotional items may be awarded in addition to the prize money

INDEMNIFICATION AND RELEASE

1. PGT Poker Room reserves the right to refuse entry into the tournament
2. All winners will be required to provide their name, current address and telephone number which will be stored as a record of the prize received
